<p>Work Life: What were the jobs or careers of the main characters? Did they seem happy with their work or school life?</p>	<p>Social Classes: Were there slaves, peasants, merchants, nobles, etc.? To which social class did the main character(s) belong?</p>	<p>Clothing: What did the people wear? Would this clothing have kept people comfortable?</p>	<p>Food: What did they eat? What did they grow on the farms? How was food obtained, prepared and served?</p>
