# **Bayside's Leaky Roof**

For 20 years Bayside has been contending with a leaky roof. PAC got behind the campaign (with additional support from our local MLA) to nudge our plight to being top priority for the Minister of Education. After a short campaign we received amazing news. If you have not heard, YES - "We've got a new roof!" Hon. Minister Mike Bernier was at Bayside to make a spectacular announcement that the Province of BC has approved \$6.1 Million to partner with the School District's \$1 Million to get Bayside's roof COMPLETELY fixed by 2017! So this is very exciting for everyone who studies at, teaches at, works at and visits Bayside to have the promise of a completely refurbished facility by fall of 2017! Roof, ceilings, walls, sky lights!

We understand that work will commence this summer 2016 with a priority to fix the gym and North Pod. The other pod roofs will be replaced during the Spring and Summer of 2017.

Thank you to EVERYONE who helped make this incredible announcement possible! Your hard work and dedication made this happen! So very proud of and happy for Bayside! Woo, Hoo!
