PURPOSE:

- To reuse “gently used” items
- To trade for new-to-you items
- To reduce the amount of stuff we consume. Less consumption equals a happier planet!
- To rethink how we shop
- To actually “do business” like citizens of ancient civilizations

MATERIALS:

- On Wednesday, Dec 9th please have in a standard sized grocery bag filled with 10 GENTLY USED items to trade. In other words, you need to be able to carry your items into the school.

REMEMBER: THESE ITEMS ARE NEVER GOING BACK TO YOUR HOUSE.
So you MUST ASK YOUR PARENTS BEFORE you take the items to school

- If you wish to bring more, you can donate these to the “Free Store” for other students who were not able to bring items.
- You will have a “market stall” with one other person so that one person can “watch the store” while the other can “go shopping”.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- At some point before the fair, your teacher will go over how one trades or barter using items vs. money.
- In block 1 your teacher will tell you where to set up your “stall” with your labelled desk (masking tape with your name and classroom #). Your “stall”/desk will be set up in the hall of your pod which comes off the gallery. We are trying to stay out of the actual pods.
- If you are unsure if a trade is a “good trade” you can call in one of the TRADER BROKERS (aka the teachers of South pod) who will be wandering the fair with signs “TRADER BROKER” on their shirts.
- In block 3 at approx. 10:30 we will start taking down our market.
- If someone is acting inappropriately, please let an adult know asap.
