## YES-2-IT Overview

Dear parents/guardians,

ITA (Industry Training Authority) is the government body responsible for providing technical training for over 100 different trades in BC. They are very concerned that BC will be facing a significant shortage of skilled trade workers in the next decade and they are taking proactive steps to minimize the short fall by encouraging youth to examine trades as a viable education and career pathway. Their primary tool for creating awareness about trade occupations at an early age is a program called **YES-2-IT**, which is an acronym for "Youth Exploring Skills to Industry Training". YES-2-IT programs are aimed at middle school aged students from grade 6 to grade 9.

The idea of a YES-2-IT activity is to expose students to a variety of trade areas through hands on learning activities and relevant information sessions. In keeping with initiatives set out by the ITA and Ministry of Education, Saanich School District has undertaken a significant project that will provide every grade 8 student in the district an opportunity to visit their destination high school during the week of January 22<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> for a trade exploration day. Students will participate in a "pre" YES-2-IT activity sonsosred by Skills Canada called "InSpire" at their home school followed by a half day visit to the high school where they will get to learn by doing. The event will be followed up with a "post" YES-2-IT activity a few days after returning to their home school that will cause students to reflect on whether they like to: make things, fix things, operate things, or work with materials. An extension of the follow-up is an activity for parents to do with their students. It's a "What did you do at school today?" discussion guide. Our hope is that parents will take a few minutes in the evening or over dinner to discuss the YES-2-IT event with their children.

We hope your children enjoy YES-2-IT and benefit from the knowledge and experience gained by participating in this event.

- 10. What is the earning potential in the trades?


