#### ATTENDANCE ALERT PROGRAM



Attendance Alert is a MANDATORY program to help ensure your child is accounted for if they are not at school. If your child will not be attending school or is expected to arrive late, please send an email to bayside\_attendance@saanichschools.ca or phone the Attendance Alert Line at 250-652-8653. Leave a clear, brief message with the following

information: Student's Name; Your Name; Division or Homeroom Teacher's Name; and Reason/Length of Absence. Attendance is taken during the homeroom session (8:30 am - 8:34 am) and submitted to Student Services. If your child is arriving late (after 8:30) he/she MUST report to Student Services to sign in.

#### STUDENT INFO VERIFICATION FORM



Carefully check your child's information on the Student Verification form and make any required changes in pen, preferably using any colour ink other than black. This form should be returned to your child's teacher by Monday, September 20th so we can update our data. As this information will be used by classroom teachers and in the event of an emergency, we thank you for ensuring our records are correct.

# PARENT VOLUNTEERS AND DRIVERS



Parents/Guardians who wish to volunteer and/or drive on field trips require a current Criminal Record Check. Please apply online to the Ministry of Justice at https://justice.gov.bc.ca/eCRC/ and use Access Code UV53DWHBYX. Your Criminal

Record Check will be sent to the School Board Office for review.

#### **Volunteer Drivers**

In addition to completing a Criminal Record Check, Volunteer Drivers are required to complete the following steps each school year:

- Bring the completed form to your school office along with a copy of your Driver's Abstract, Driver's License and insurance document.
